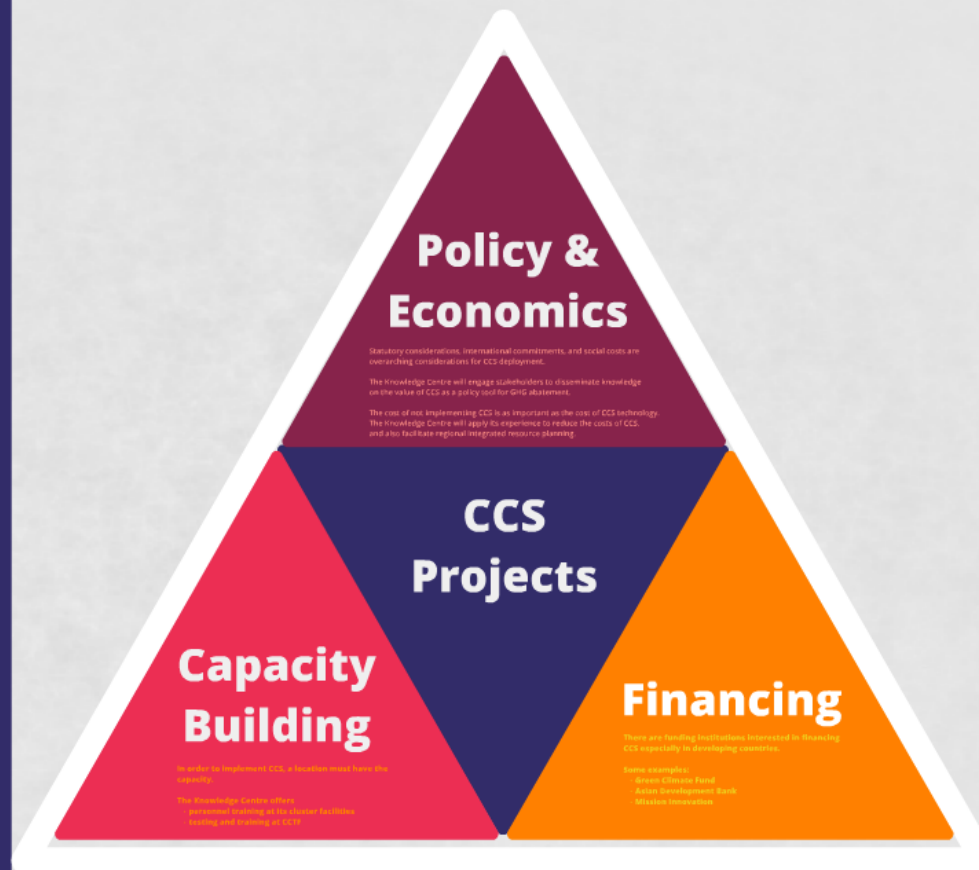

Policy & Economics

Statutory considerations, international commitments, and social costs are overarching considerations for CCS deployment.

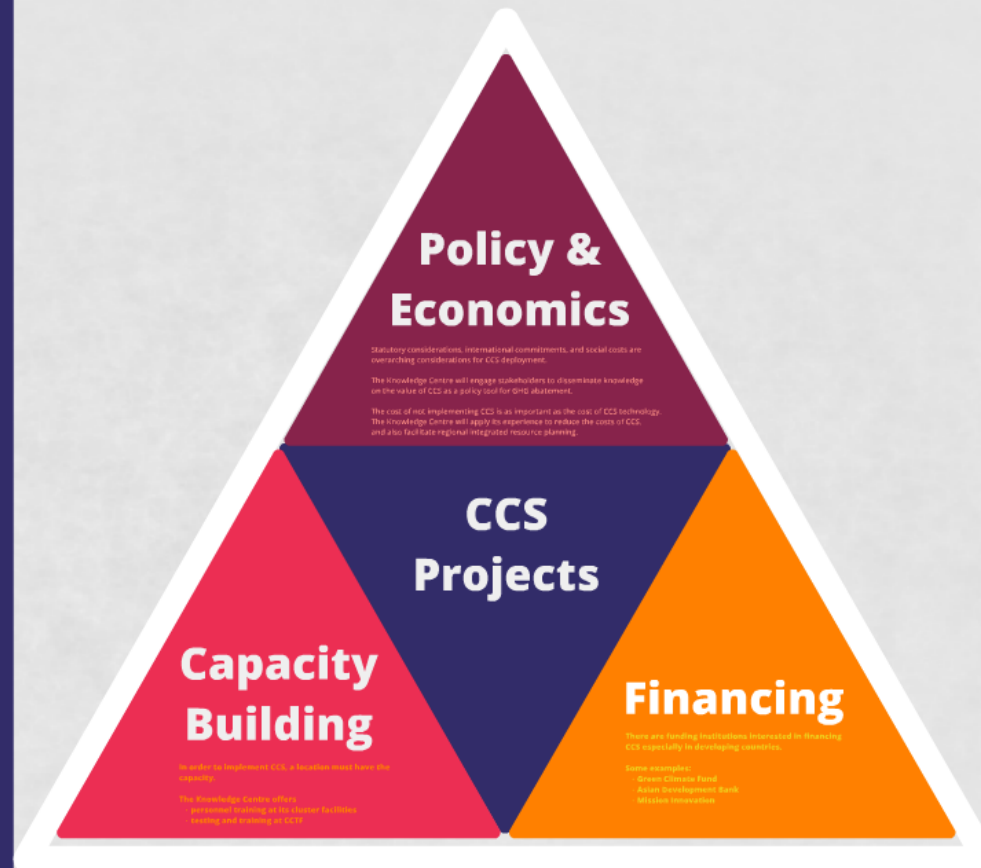
